

Central Connecticut Baseball and Softball Field Rules

The baseball and softball fields are brand new this year. TCB is very fortunate to have access to these first-class facilities. Please be respectful to the fields and surrounding campus. Please treat these facilities like they are your own. The following guidelines/rules need to be followed by all coaches, players, and parents. If these guidelines/rules are not followed, TCB risks losing the facility for future use.

- Park in the upper football field lot only. Do NOT park in the lot near the baseball/soccer field. The bottom lot will lock cars in, do NOT park in the bottom lot.
- NO sunflower seeds in the dugouts or on the field.
- NO gum in the dugouts or the field.
- NO food or drinks allowed on the field.
- NO tobacco products in the dugouts or the field.
- NO balls hit into any of the fences. There are batting cages at the fields, do NOT hit balls into the fences.
- Clean your dugout when you are done.
- Place all garbage, trash, bottles, etc in the trash bins.
- NO hanging on the fences in the dugouts.
- NO standing on the benches in the dugouts.
- NO parents allowed in dugouts or on the field. ONLY coaches and players are allowed in the dugouts and on the field.

Please treat these tremendous facilities with respect and pride. We want to keep our fields, dugouts, and bleachers beautiful. We have games this spring, and recruits on campus all the time. We want to keep our facilities looking brand new. We appreciate your help and concern.
