The History of Perfect Game

Perfect Game was founded in 1994 by Jerry Ford. Ford had an extensive scouting and college coaching background in the Upper Midwest. The original owners included Ford, former Major League player and Manager Bruce Kimm, Brad Stovie and Jason Gerst. The original 4 employees of the organization were Jerry, his son Andy (a former minor league player with the Reds), Tyson Kimm (Creighton, Philadelphia Phillies minor leaguer and son of ex ML player/manager Bruce Kimm) and Jason Gerst (former college standout).

It is very important to know that those four original employees are all still with the company and leading it to the next level. There are no more experienced showcase and elite tournament organizers in the country. This group has organized and run literally hundreds of events.

Perfect Game now has grown to include approximately 55 employees who live in close to a dozen states. Perfect Game also employs hundreds of part time workers. The 2001 Perfect Game schedule included 12 events. The 2005 Perfect Game schedule currently lists 73 events and more are being added all the time. Nearly all of the Perfect Game staff has experience at the professional level as a scout or player and most of the others have extensive college level experience.

Perfect Game has become the world's largest scouting report service, reporting on thousands of young players each year. Baseball America and Perfect Game are partners in producing Prospects Plus, baseball's #1 scouting service. Perfect Game uses its resources to help others involved in amateur baseball. Whether it's helping USA Baseball scout the Junior Olympics in Arizona and Florida or sponsoring the famous Lions Tournament in San Diego, Perfect Game is there to lend a helping hand.

The huge Perfect Game database of players and the endless year round scouting of young players have produced some eye popping numbers. The player files that often contain years of information have proven to be very valuable to scouting departments and college recruiters. Nowhere in baseball is there this much player information compiled. This information often provides a long baseball history of the top players and that data can, in fact, help in many areas including projection.

In the past three years players who have attended Perfect Game events have accounted for the following astounding results.

- Over 1,300 Major League Draft Picks (By far the most of any organization in baseball history)
- 66 First Round selections (By far the most of any organization in baseball history)
- Over 550 players drafted in 2004 (By far the most of any organization)
- Over 350 players on the 8 college World Series rosters. (By far the most of any organization)
- 154 players in the 2004 College World Series (By far the most of any organization)
- Thousands of college players. (By far the most of any organization in baseball history)
- Over 50 Free Agent signings from Latin America.
- The numbers increase greatly each year

The PG Database contains well over 35,000 prospects and close to 250,000 names and information about players.

It has been estimated that by the year 2009 over one half of all those playing in the Major Leagues will be former PG participants.

Perfect Game has over one half of the 30 MLB Scouting Directors on the PG Scouting Committee. PG reports to all 30 MLB Clubs.

Perfect Game works with most all major college programs in America.

Perfect Game expansion plans include more overseas activity. Perfect Game also plans to help revolutionize scouting with advanced technology over the next year.

Scouting WWBA/BCS Events

Perfect Game staff members scout every game of every WWBA/BCS tournament. By "scout" we mean the staff member(s) have radar guns, stop watches and take as many notes as possible on player's tools and skills. These notes are entered into the PG Player Database and become part of our record on every player.

Being in the PG system and potentially being included in the Perfect Game national and state by state rankings is perhaps the most valuable benefit of competing in a WWBA/BCS or Perfect Game event. College coaches and recruiters from around the country and even professional teams scrutinize these lists, depend on them for information and call the PG offices daily asking for reports on players. The lists and reports are continually updated as we see players develop, often over two or three or even four years.

How many recruiters and scouts are at any one event depends on the time of year, the type of the event and the overall quality of the teams. The biggest WWBA event, the World Championships in October, draw over 600 coaches and scouts. Other events such as the National 18U and 17U championships in July draw well over 100 such observers. Other events can vary widely from year to year and from event to event. But the bottom line is that the Perfect Game staff is at the event and scouting it...that's the most important thing.

There are over 1,200 college and junior college baseball programs in the country. We can't say for sure that every one of those programs doesn't access and scrutinize the Perfect Game player rankings and reports. But we have yet to find a school that doesn't.

Other Baseball Organizations

It is very important to note that membership in the WWBA/BCS does not compete with, threaten or in any way lessen a team or individual's player's involvement with long established organizations such as Babe Ruth Baseball, American Legion Baseball, Connie Mack Baseball (AABC) or others. The WWBA/BCS is discussing mutual opportunities with some of these organizations right now that will hopefully help both the groups and the individual players and teams in the future.

The World Wood Bat Association's focus is reaching up and outward to expose young players everywhere to the best levels of competition that they can aspire to. These other fine organizations are reaching out broadly everywhere to provide structure and opportunities to as many young baseball players as possible.

WWBA vs. Baseball Championship Series. What's the Difference?

The most basic difference between the WWBA and the BCS is that WWBA events feature only wood bats, while metal bats are used in BCS events.

Otherwise, the tournaments are run under the same formats and by the same PG staff members. They are scouted the same with the same goals of collecting prospect information and the scores and results posted in the same manner on the website.

Many of the present WWBA events are stand alone events that crown a national or world champion. Initially, most of the BCS events will serve as qualifiers to the BCS World Series, to be held in 2005 at the Humphrey Dome in Minneapolis, home of the AL Central champion Minnesota Twins.
