What is the PGBA?

The Perfect Game Baseball Association is the sanctioning body for all tournaments under the "PG" flag. The Perfect Game Baseball Association is dedicated to promoting and protecting the game of baseball at all age levels. This is accomplished by enforcing higher standards on tournament directors, identifying the best tournaments worthy of affiliation, and providing a quality experience to all players, coaches, and parents.

What are the benefits of playing in PGBA affiliated events?

Great venues & competition to fit your team with the PGBA Red, White & Blue divisions. Other features include the ability to follow games online, player profiles for all participants, stats and much more.

What is the difference between Red, White & Blue PGBA Events?

Red

- Highest level of PGBA events
- Core tournaments operated by PG Full-Time staff
- Scouts at every field (Velocities record 13U up)
- Scorekeepers provided by Perfect Game
- Coverage on PG Website and social media
- All-Tournament Teams Selected by PG
- Multiple awards including MVP and MVPitcher

White

- Quality tournament operated by affiliate director
- Scorekeepers provided for every game
- Qualifying tournaments for berths to elite PG events
- All-Tournament Teams published on PG website
- Team and Individual Awards
- Replicating the PG Experience at a more regional event

Blue

- Quality tournament operated by affiliate director
- Directors are not required to provide scorekeepers
- Various awards depending on the event
- Organized and well-run tournaments at all ages
- Provide more value than other options for local events
- Check details for tournament expectation

Will velocities be posted from PGBA events?

Velocities will only be recorded to player profiles from Red events.

How will I know if DiamondKast will be run at an event?

Diamond Kast is available at all Red events, and Select White events. Events in which DiamondKast will be run will have the DiamondKast logo next to them on the main schedule page.

How do I get my Roster Listed online?

The team contact will receive an emailed link to click on to update the roster online.

What is the tournament format?

Each tournament will have a different format, depending on how many teams and how many games will be played. It will be noted on the specific tournament page prior to the event.

How do I contact the event director?



Use the "Contact Us" button at the top of the event homepage.

My player information for a tournament is not correct, how do I fix it?

Perfect Game does not enter this data, please see your coach first to correct it. If that does not work, send an email including your player name, graduation year, city, state, player ID, the email you use to login, and corrections needed to one of the Tournament Management Assistants listed on the contact page.

I am having trouble signing the Participant and Media Releases. How do I do this?

1. Sign into your account. If you do not have an account, please create one by clicking "Create Account" in the upper right corner.
2. Click "My Account". On the "My Account" page, click the red 'Associate Player to your account' button. Fill out the form.
3. Once the association request is approved, you will receive an email notifying you that it has been approved. Sign into your account on the Perfect Game website and there will be a red notification box with two links to sign the releases.

If your player does not appear in a search, it is because your player has not yet attended a Perfect Game event, their coach has not rostered them for an event, or they have not been approved on a roster yet.

How are credits held for PGBA tournaments?

Credits are held by the specific event director, and are not transferable to other directors.

How do I become a PGBA Affiliate Director?

Take your events to the next level by applying for PGBA affiliation. All affiliated events are posted on the PG event schedule and given their own tournament page on the Perfect Game website. Affiliate Directors gain access to PG's admin platform and many other resources to host the highest quality events.

How do I submit a DiamondKast stat correction for review?

All potential stat corrections should be emailed to stats@perfectgame.org. Requests will be reviewed, and responded to within 72 hours.

Corrections must include the following information to be eligible for review:

1. Event Name
2. Date
3. Game # and Team Names
4. Players whose stats require a correction
5. Description of error

What is the PGBA Membership fee? Is it required to play in an event?

PGBA Membership is required prior to participation in a Red, White or Blue event. The PGBA Membership fee is \$60.00, and up for renewal on August 15th.

What is the refund or credit policy for PGBA events?

No refunds will be issued at any time after payment. The tournament director will hold a credit to a future event if notice of cancellation is given at least 3 weeks prior to the event start date.
